



## Plans Before Consulting

Be sure to arrange most of your wedding plans before consulting a Flowerama designer. It is more productive to discuss flowers after you have chosen styles and colors for dresses, table linens etc. In most cases, it is not necessary to see us until 90 to 120 days prior to the wedding date. Here are a few things to know prior to meeting with Flowerama Florists:

1. What does the Church/Synagogue allow or disallow at the ceremony? Do they provide flowers or have permanent decorations.
2. Are there any other Church/Synagogue functions scheduled for your wedding day?
3. Are there any flowers included in your reception package? Have you seen samples?
4. Who may we contact at the reception hall to arrange delivery times and decorating details?
5. What flowers do the mothers and father prefer?
6. Should the corsages be made for the wrist or the shoulder?
7. Other than the bridal party, what relatives and close friends would you like to have or wear flowers?
8. When is the photographer scheduled to be shooting? Where will the photographer be taking pictures?
9. Bring swatches of dress material.
10. Bring photos of bouquets, flowers, arrangements and styles you like.
